2010 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS FOR CAREERS IN AVIATION

The Aero Club of Pennsylvania Memorial Scholarship Fund is pleased to announce its annual Memorial Scholarship Awards Program. Scholarships are available to young men and women interested in pursuing careers in the aviation industry, including aerospace engineering, flight training, aircraft maintenance, avionics repair and design, airport management, air traffic control and other aviation-related fields.

You must reside in the Philadelphia / Greater Delaware Valley Area, and have completed your first solo flight for a flight training scholarship or show the equivalent demonstrated commitment to, or accredited course work for other aviation career paths. Awards will be made to US citizens without regard to sex, race, religion, or national origin.

All applications must be received by **May 1**. Application forms must be accompanied by two (2) letters of recommendation, a transcript of your most recent education and 500-word typed essay. For flight training scholarships, copies of all aviation licenses, medical certificate and the last three pages of your logbook also must be included. For other training scholarships, proof should be submitted of acceptance to an accredited A&P program or approved FAR Part 147 School, or to an aviation-related program.

To be considered, applicants must be available for a personal interview with the Scholarship Review Committee on **May 15** at Brandywine Airport in West Chester, PA. Applicants who are selected for an award must also attend the Scholarship Awards Dinner on **June 17**. Dinner for the recipient and one guest will be compliments of the Aero Club. Additional guests are welcome with a standard dinner charge.

The winner(s) will be announced by **May 31**. Successful candidates will be notified by mail. All candidates will be given a free one year membership in the Aero Club of Pennsylvania and are encouraged to reapply.
